It is time to clean out those attics, basements, and garages for the annual Spring Clean Up Weekend! Friday May 31st – Sunday June 3rd. Hours will be posted on Facebook and at the Post Office.

Disposal cost is free for city residents (who currently pay for garbage services billed through the City of Salix). All drop-offs will be checked by an attendant.

Paint, tires, cement, broken glass, construction material or hazardous materials are not accepted.

There is a \$25 charge for each TV disposal. The attendant accepts cash, or you may ask to have it charged to your garbage bill.

Most appliances will be accepted (i.e.: stoves, washing machines, dryers, air conditioners, microwaves, water heaters, etc.) but are to be placed on a separate trailer for recycling.




Holiday Trash Pick-Up
