It is time to clean out those attics, basements, and garages for the annual Spring Clean Up Weekend! Drop off times are as follows:

FRIDAY (5/31) SATURDAY (6/1) SUNDAY (6/2) 10AM - 12PM 10AM - 2PM 1PM - 3PM

Disposal cost is free for city residents (<u>who currently pay for</u> <u>garbage services billed through the City of Salix</u>). All drop-offs will be checked by an attendant.

Paint, tires, cement, broken glass, construction material or hazardous materials are not accepted.

There is a \$25 charge for each TV disposal. Attendant accepts cash, or you may ask to have it charged to your garbage bill.

Most appliances will be accepted (i.e.: stoves, washing machines, dryers, air conditioners, microwaves, water heaters, etc.) but are to be placed on a separate trailer for recycling. If you are unable to make the drop off time, please call Ed at 712-490-6734.

TORNADO SEASON IS UPON US

Tornado season typically runs between June and July for the Midwest states. But tornadoes can strike at any time of the year. Know the difference between a watch (conditions are favorable for a tornado to form) and a warning (a tornado has been spotted in your area and you should take shelter immediately). There is a tornado shelter inside the Salix fire station if you need a place to seek shelter.

RATE CHANGES

The council has approved three readings for changes to the water, sewer, garbage, and landfill rates. Water and sewer usage rates will increase by 3% to help cover costs of price increases in chemicals and water plant maintenance. Landfill rates decreased by .55cents and garbage rates increased \$1.50.
